God's Garden must be beautiful

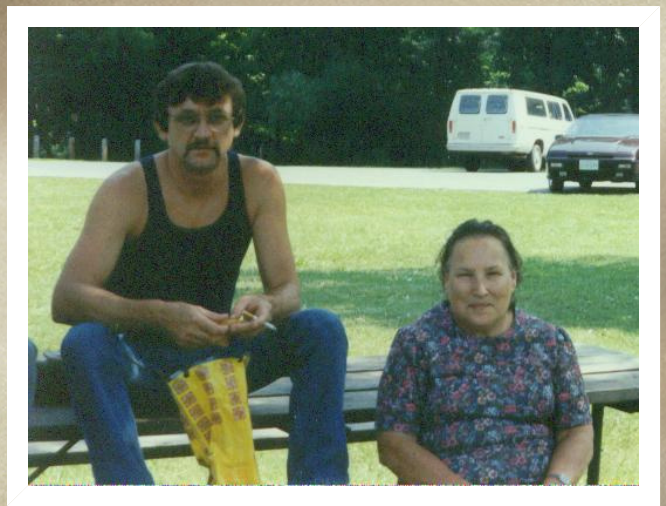
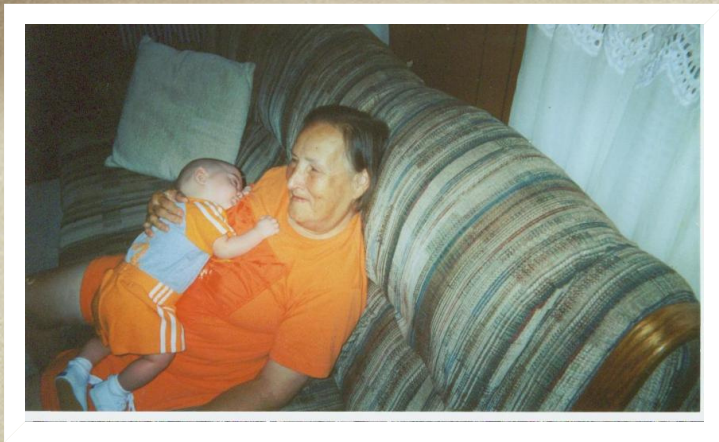
*God looked around the garden,

and whispered peace be thine.*

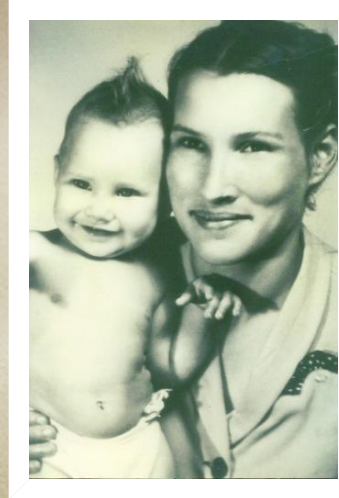

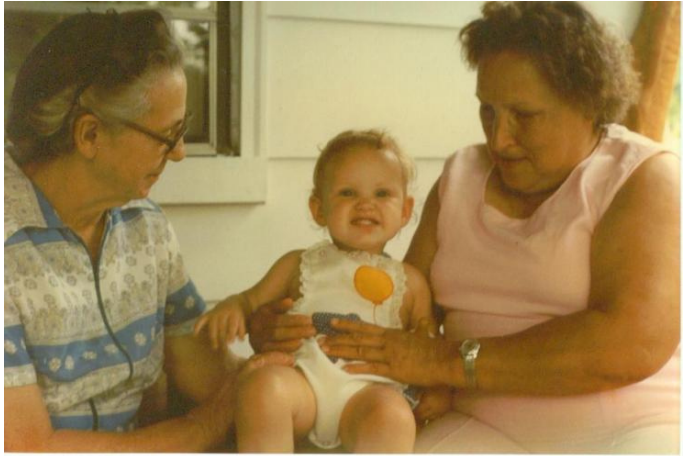
